Events in Darfur, Sudan since 2003

have resulted in the death or injury of over 400,000 civilians. DARFUR/DARFUR was created to help bring this to the attention of the public and to advocate for immediate and lasting peace. This exhibition, depicting the crisis, endeavors to place the brutal realities faced in Darfur in context with its vibrant culture and people. We hope to put

a human face on the continuing atrocities and prompt international support for the prevention of further destruction of life. Launched in New York in September 2006, our goal is to take these images, music, and words to 24 venues over the next 24 months. Funds raised in connection with the event will be used for increasing public awareness of the crisis and to assist hu-

manitarian groups providing on the ground medical and social care in the region. Darfur/Darfur has partnered with Global Grassroots, a 501c3 non-profit organization, whose mission is to support the relief of underprivileged women worldwide through investment in social entrepreneurship and creative advocacy campaigns.
